Vaginal yeast infection (also called vaginal candidiasis) affects as many as three out of four women at some point in their lifetimes. Most women experience at least two episodes.

Medications and health conditions like antibiotics, hormonal contraceptives, and pregnancy can increase the risk of developing an infection. There are also several lifestyle factors, such as douching, using scented feminine hygiene products, and wearing tight or wet undergarments for long periods, that contribute to an overgrowth of yeast.
